

Year 1 curriculum

Parents information

Classroom routine

To help the children to make a smooth and comfortable move into year one they will have access to our Star Garden resources and will be able to learn while they play. The children will be put into two groups to help to give them individual support and positive feedback. This will run until the children are comfortable. Then they can begin to learn in a more formal classroom environment.

Phonics

Phonics is a key aspect of the Year 1 curriculum. Your child will have daily phonics sessions in a small group. This is to prepare them for a national Phonics Screening Check that they will need to complete in the Summer term.

Routines

At the start of the day the children will be welcomed into school through the key stage one door. This is located in the playground at the front of the school on Mayfield Road. The children will also be collected from this door at the end of the day.

Library Afternoon

Once the children are settled the Key stage one team will run a library afternoon once every fortnight. This will give you the opportunity to come into class and read with the children. A letter will be sent to inform you when this will begin.

Snack

Morning: The children will be given a free piece of fruit and a drink of milk for their morning snack. They will be able to eat this at break time.

Afternoon: If you would like your child to have a healthy snack before home time please provide a piece of fruit

P.E

The children will take part in a P.E lesson twice a week. They will need a white P.E shirt, black shorts and a pair of PE pumps. Please put your child's name in all of their clothing so that it is easy to find when getting changed,. We recommend having a draw string bag to put it in.

Homework

The children will be given a reading book and a reading journal. This will be given out alongside a piece of Math's work on a Friday. These should be returned before the following Tuesday. Please write a comment in the journal so that we know your child has read the book they are given. If this is completed their book will be swapped.

As the children become more familiar with the routines, Talk homework will also be given out.
